



Finally, I would like to thank and offer the best of wishes to all the participants of GLITZ Design Honour Awards 2023. Wishing triumph to the design that excels above all!



Preserving Traditions, Shaping Spaces

A Journey through Indian Art and Craft at Knowledge Series 2023



he IIID Vadodara Regional Chapter, a part of the esteemed Indian Institute of Interior Designer and one of the 32 Chapters/Centres pan India, successfully hosted the "ABHIGAYANAM" series, also known as Knowledge Series, on Saturday, 15th July 2023. The event aimed to impart knowledge through presentations and experiences shared by esteemed guest speakers. For this edition of the Knowledge Series, the invite was extended to two renowned architects - Ar. Geetanjali Kasliwal from Jaipur and Ar. Vivek Rathore from Kolkata.



Ar. Geetanjali Kasliwal began her presentation by emphasising the integration of Indian Art and Craft with architecture and interior design. She highlighted how this integration can not only preserve traditional art forms but also generate revenue for the artisans involved. Geetanjali showcased examples of spaces where Indian traditional art and craft were skilfully incorporated to create spaces that truly reflected the essence of Indian culture. A notable example she shared was the use of "thathara" craft at Delhi Airport in the mudra sculpture, beautifully transforming a traditional art form into a modern-day masterpiece.

Continuing on the same theme, Ar. Vivek Rathore took the stage to present practical executions of designs using Indian traditional art and craft forms at his firm, Salient Design Studio, Kolkata. He elucidated on the seven design principles they follow while integrating these art forms into their projects. Vivek's presentation emphasised the importance of reviving and redefining endangered art and craft forms to ensure their continuity and relevance in contemporary settings. By showcasing real-life projects, he demonstrated how traditional craftsmanship can breathe life into modern designs.

The Knowledge Series brought to light the responsibility of designers to protect and promote Indian art and craft forms, some of which are on the verge of extinction. The event underscored how these valuable traditional practices can be reimagined for modern-day use, benefitting not only the designers and their projects but also providing sustainable livelihoods for the skilled artisans.

The "Knowledge Series (Term 2021-2023)" featuring Ar. Geetanjali Kasliwal and Ar. Vivek Rathore was a resounding success. Attendees were enlightened on the potential of integrating Indian Art and Craft with architecture and interior design, fostering a deeper appreciation for the country's rich artistic heritage. The event provided valuable insights into the seamless fusion of tradition and innovation, urging designers to play an active role in preserving and promoting India's diverse art and craft forms. 




Section Muktangan Railway Station

The design of the station buildings reminds of the fluidity of a Dupatta, an Indian piece of Clothing saving the passengers from direct sun and rain. The station has commercial features with shops and food kiosks distributed in the piazza.

The skylights allow light to penetrate the piazza, giving it a sense of openness and transparency. Green spaces were added to provide peace in the midst of the chaos, which included sitting and food courts which are open to the public to relax and interact.

The piazza is user-friendly, with Central Business Districts and other mixed-use developments taking advantage of the elevated track mound on the left and right sides.

"These land parcels are to be developed as the walkable centers.



ocated in the middle of an urban area of Vadodara, India, the site was a linear plot surrounded by houses on the east and west parallel sides. Having an opportunity to design a dwelling with all spaces opening into pockets of vertical voids, the dwelling is aligned in the north-south direction with openings facilitating maximum cross ventilation. The client's vision was to have a home that invites interaction within the envelope of the house and invites landscaping in the lifestyle.

The spatial planning articulates from concepts of rectilinear geometry where each floor is alternately staggered, forming double-height volumes. The dwelling radiates serenity, a zen-like ambiance interweaving the built environment and landscaping. The designers have integrated elements of various crafting details throughout the house. The central double-height space serves as a





focal point and separates the public spaces from private ones. Furthermore, the house is elevated from the ground by adding landscape and walkways connecting to the main foyer.

An eye-striking facade captures the spectator's vision through the drama created from an earthy material palette infused on the backdrop walls of the robust mass. Evolving the climatic concern of the firm's sustainable material identity, clay bricks of rustic tones are fixed on the perpendicular surfaces. Box frames of various proportions pop out as pockets of balconies and terrace gardens on above floors.

The art of brick patterns defines the bonds in aesthetics, transforming the conventional way into contemporary expressions. Some bricks are crafted as undulating blocks, aiming to create perforated brick claddings in the front. Various brick moulding strips orient arch forms, bubble cuts, and semicircular forms flowing on the accent wall.







The entrance walkway, shaded by canopies of plantations, is paved with natural yellow-toned stone contrasting the black stone. The living room sets against the backdrop of the same stone juxtaposed with flexi ply wooden work in grey rustic wall finish and Italian marble flooring. The blue-toned upholstery balances the composition. The elongated TV unit frame can hold artifacts, plantations, or even books.








This overlay of thoughtfully curated elements gives one an idea of the spatial drama going through. Moving on to the voluminous dining space, the floor plan has an open central cutout overlooking the connection for the passage and bedroom window openings. Adding here, this turns as a light well of natural source, providing cooling ventilation and different internal views to bedrooms placed on either side on the above floor.

The central passage has mixed geometric flooring from Italian marble and yellow stone. The kitchen has an open island concept for cooking, where a green character over the platform adds to the ambiance. Bold use of muted red for kitchen cabinetry brightens up the area.

Walking up to the first floor, the staircase wall has small wooden carved details on the wall to have a travel experience. The master bedroom faces the front elevation, opening to a balcony sit-out covered with pergolas. The bed back elevates a contrasting palette of materials like tropical tiles with fluted tiles and blue rustic-toned headboard support. Evolving new possibilities of decorative furniture pieces. Elegant side units are styled in classic detailing. The master bedroom is attached to a walk-in wardrobe cum bathing area, which encloses a semi-circular alcove in black mosaics highlighting the walls. An accent wall in the bathroom shows the vibrant palette of colorful rustic tiles.







Another bedroom on the same floor explores the depth of different materials inlaid with clay roof tiles in squares. Printed graphics and neutral black color style the boldness of the bedroom backdrop. A walk-in closet and bath allow one to have an experience of ensuite bedrooms. These two bedrooms overlook the below double-height space, allowing for barrierfree communication.

Further, the first-floor stairs lead to the second floor, continuing the theme of the mural wall art on the staircase wall for a visual experience. The master bedroom

on this floor exhibits free forms of exposed brick walls, complemented by graphical tile prints, rustic stone tiles interweave radial fabrics. Wooden laminates create a headboard theme for the bed back.

Free-standing side units enhance the composition with the play of lights. The bedroom opens to a sitout balcony for relaxation. The master bedroom links to a walk-in closet, having a twisted approach to





the bathing cubicle, which is at an angle. Striking red color mosaics emboss the tilt walls with the play of RGB lights in the ceiling for an ambient experience. The console basin well defines the modernity and spacious planning of the same.





The terrace garden on the last floor exhibits the concept of zen gardens that transition between built mass and greenery with sit-out pockets. It adds a feature of a tropical area inserted for leisure.



This important aspect worked wonders for the finished look of the house. The stark flooring elevated the interiors of the house, giving it a very contemporary appearance and creating a well-balanced contrast between the furniture and the floor. This led them to give the rug a miss, which would overshadow the beauty of this synergy. To accommodate a large number of guests, the seating arrangement of the living room was spread out evenly but at the same time kept intimate so that when only the four inmates sat together, it was still cosy. The large windows in the rectangular-shaped living room ensure ample natural light while a corner has been reserved to display artwork on an easel that has been created by the owner herself, who is also a renowned artist. 




The master bedroom is designed with simplicity for a clutter-free experience. The colour palette has been limited to pastels that bring life to the room along with specially sourced accessories such as hanging lights, an armchair, and an ottoman that adds the perfect amount of charm to this comforting space.











The interiors of their daughter's room are in shades of mint green that bring in an admired youthfulness and energy into the ambiance. It also houses paintings made by the client (her mom) which are in harmony with the look and feel of the space. With a walk-in wardrobe, a comfortable lounge chair, and a window-facing study table that allows ample natural light, this room manages to tick all the boxes in the client's wish list along with keeping it spacious. For their son's room, we narrowed in on a dark ceiling - which most people do not agree with, due to it making small spaces look more compact. Nevertheless, our clients were surprisingly open about the idea and keen on creating something different without imposing any restrictions. Therefore, we created an unusual-looking space with flooring that has been diving into two segments - marble and wood. This break was added to enhance the aesthetics of the room while the walls and the ceiling have a concrete finish to them. Wooden battens were also added to the ceiling for a rough look that suits the personality of a young man.





The client wanted a lavish kitchen that would accommodate all their requirements. Since their kids love to cook in their free time, the kitchen has a very young and vibrant vibe with all the modern equipment and appliances at their disposal for all kinds of cooking. We managed to create a bigger kitchen by tweaking the layout, which now also houses the client's hand-painted porcelain ware along with a fully equipped pantry and crockery unit. The guest room designed for multiple uses consists of a huge sofa cum bed, which can be turned into a bedroom when the guests arrive. It also doubles as a family room where they can sit and watch TV or entertain a few guests. During parties, this room is converted into a cards room, and it serves its purpose well with its flexible design. Another notable feature is the bar with the blue antique glazed and gold-leafed bar unit and the crystal clad ceiling.

Months of brainstorming, conceptualizing, and diligence have resulted in creating a space that is functional, roomy, and radiant. With several art pieces displayed across the house, this abode is sure to attract the fancy of every artist around. From a large kitchen that accommodates every essential to a living room that is equipped to host several guests, this house is truly designed to be their dream home.

evarpit is a bungalow located in Sambalpur City, Odisha, designed for a joint family of eight people. The main goal of the design was to create a space that promotes easy movement for family members while maintaining privacy. The previous house faced challenges with frequent visits from relatives and business associates, disrupting the family's daily functioning. To address this, the design focused on creating stress-free interactive spaces that were connected yet private.


The site, spanning 0.5 acres, faces southwest and is surrounded by a playground to the east and a warehouse to the north and west. The building is positioned to the north to maximize exposure to the playground and south-facing landscaping. This layout ensures that all areas of the plot are accessible without any secluded





spaces. The site features a large landscaped area to the south, with waterbodies positioned to the east, south, and between the verandah and common areas of the building.

The site hierarchy creates a welcoming atmosphere with lush green grass and tall trees enhancing the bungalow's view. The entry gate is strategically positioned to allow visitors to appreciate the architecture and environment. The pathway gradually reveals different architectural features, offering unique views from different angles. Porches at different levels provide views of different sections of the garden and waterbodies. A green space acts as an ambient environment between the building and boundary wall. The terraces offer panoramic views of the playground and landscape.





Saraswat Sekhar Sarangi

He places a greater emphasis on understanding the needs of the client rather than just their wants. Consideration was given to the placement and orientation of the building. Rooms that are vacant during working hours and only used in the evenings and mornings are located on the southern side to minimize direct heat gain. Common use spaces like the dining and living areas, which are in use throughout the day, are

centrally placed to benefit from natural lighting and avoid direct heat. Rooms used by elders and guests, such as the drawing hall, Pooja room, parents' bedroom, and guest room, are positioned on the

northern side to receive diffused light without direct heat.

An open-to-sky waterbody is located on the eastern side of the building, adjacent to the verandah, allowing wind flow through the waterbody and enabling sunlight to reach the dining area. A tree inside the waterbody acts as a visual barrier between the entry verandah and the dining space.

Considering the wind flow from southwest to northeast, large windows are placed on the south facades to capture the breeze and channel it to the northern part of the building. A waterbody on the south side helps bring cool breeze inside. To mitigate direct sunlight on the south-facing windows, large overhanging projections are planned based on the angle of the sun during summer.








The floor plans were developed based on the family's space use patterns and requirements. A space use matrix was created to identify the most suitable positions for various rooms in different areas. The final plan ensures that all family members have easy access to the spaces they need, without overcrowding or leaving any areas underutilised.

his 1,850 sq ft abode for a family of 3 in Ahmedabad features an open layout with well-ventilated spaces that are closely connected with nature, put together with a graceful coordination of pastel shades. This not only adds flavour to the design palette but also creates an ambience of de-emphasised opulence.

Aptly called the Suave Suite, this apartment is an effortless combination of luxury and simplicity, having 3 bedrooms along with a family sitting area, dining room, and kitchen. It utilises muted design principles, imbuing them with a touch of nonchalant elegance to make a statement of luxury, sophistication, and rootedness. Natural tones and a clever blend of warm and cool shades, sprinkled with pops of colour, make up the palette of the entire home. Particular emphasis was given to achieving a minimalist, airy, and colour-rich home.

The foyer is adorned with copper-coloured mosaic, relwood, and stone veneer with fine details, giving the area a raw and robust look. To match the overall ambience, the ceiling is beautified with jute-finished MCM Cladding.



Combining all of this provides a luxurious feel to the visitor. From the first impression of the detailing shown at the entrance, one can tell that this home is special. The stylish chairs with a coffee table create a serene spot in the space.

In the vestibule, the PVC Fluted Cladding with silver stripes highlights the space in a unique way. The temple designed in the entrance spreads positivity and serenity across the house throughout the day.

Ruled by whites, browns, and beige colour palettes, the drawing room is formulated from a combination of MCM Cladding, veneer, and soft furnishings, where carefully selected artefacts complement the overall design narrative,



To bring in direct light in the dining area, we have removed the wall by converting the bedroom into a family sitting area, creating an open plan of 30' length consisting of family sitting, dining, and kitchen. The informal low-height seating emanates an easy-going ambience designed to suit the personality of the occupants. To add an exquisite look to the dining area, we have used an Onyx Italian Marble table with seating for 6. The colour theme of the dining area merges so easily with the overall aesthetics that it does not hinder circulation.










Moving towards the kitchen, it is made modular and greyish coloured with acrolam finished cabinets, creating a warm and sophisticated atmosphere. To make this space look spacious, the storage room has been removed from the layout. The existing floors of the kitchen and family sitting area are marble-printed tiles, so to add warmth and contrast with the Italian Marble, we have changed it to WPC Flooring. The sleek cabinets and modern appliances enhance functionality and style.

The colour palette chosen for the master bedroom is grey and white, creating an overall ambience in the room. Clean and simple, with ample storage, exotic cement grey textured PVC Fluted Panels and PU Finish Wardrobes are used to make the room exquisite. The addition of the circular mirror on the wall signifies the room in a unique way. The greyish coloured vinyl flooring here goes very well with the overall interior theme of this room.


